

Joining the Approved Fire Door Inspectors (Residential) Register



The Register has been set up to identify those individuals who have met our rigorous standards and who are able to prove their confidence in carrying out fire door inspections in residential premises. We hope The Register will encourage sector providers to identify peer organisations with approved in-house inspectors who may offer advice and support in developing their own fire door inspection processes.

Approved inspectors are supported via a forum for networking and technical support, guides and links to sector relevant information and access to discounted CPD webinars and training.

Stage one

Complete and successfully pass our two-day IFSM-Accredited Fire Doors in Residential Buildings Diploma (achieving at least an 80% pass mark).

Stage two

Carry out an inspection to include at least ten (10) fire doors in your own residential premises and submit a report along with photographs; these will be assessed and approved by our approvals team (note: this must be done within 12 weeks of your completing the Diploma).

Stage three

Once your completed inspections have been approved by our team and you have read and agreed to our Terms of Reference and paid the required approval fee of £195 + VAT you will be added to The Register and have access to the 'members area' on the website (note: you will be required to renew your approval every two years).
